


Business Description

Centrais Eletricas Brasileiras SA is engaged in the generation, transmission, and commercialization of electricity in Brazil. The company operates a portfolio of wind, thermal, hydro, and nuclear power plants located throughout the country. Its segments are Generation which consists of the generation of electric energy and the sale of energy to distribution companies and free consumers, and commercialization; Transmission which consists of the transmission of electric energy; and Administration activities mainly represent the Company's cash management, the management of the compulsory loan, and the management of business in SPEs, and others.

Valuation ^Qas of 16 May 2024

Centrais Eletricas achieves a 3-star quantitative star rating based on Morningstar's equity model. This reflects the company's valuation and uncertainty scores under this assessment system.

The Quantitative Fair Value estimate is 49.84, above the previous closing price of 42.03. The stock has been trading between a 42.67% and 9.41% discount to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's current valuation rating sits at the 63rd percentile in the coverage universe and 46th percentile in the utilities sector (higher percentile indicates more undervalued).

The quantitative uncertainty rating for Centrais Eletricas is Very High.

Our quantitative star rating last differed from the current rating on 05/13/2024; the uncertainty rating last differed on 05/13/2024. The previous ratings were 4 and High, respectively.

The main drivers of the company's valuation and uncertainty are its EV-MV ratio and earnings yield. The enterprise value-to-market value ratio of 1.53 falls at the 79th percentile in the equity universe and the 53rd percentile in its sector. The earnings yield of 5.31% corresponds to the 68th percentile overall and the 51st percentile in the industry.

Economic Moat ^Qas of 16 May 2024

Morningstar maintains a quantitative moat rating of None on the company. The firm's quantitative moat score of 0.42 sits at the 41st percentile in the utilities sector. This is a decrease from 0.87, the maximum of its moat scores over the past year.

The quantitative financial health rating for Centrais Eletricas is Moderate. Its financial health score, termed Distance to Default, sits at the 45th percentile in the universe and 51st percentile in the sector.

The significant drivers of these ratings are the company's book value yield and enterprise value-tomarket value ratio. The book value yield for Centrais Eletricas is 130.82%, and its enterprise value-to-market value ratio is 1.53. They sit at the 81st and 79th percentile in the global equity universe, respectively.

Fundamentals as of 16 May 2024

The earnings per share for Centrais Eletricas is 1.91. The company earns a return on invested capital of 4.67%, falling at the 42nd percentile in the utilities sector. The firm maintains a dividend yield of 4.39%. We calculate the above figures over a trailing 12-month period.

Examining valuation further, we find Centrais Eletricas holds a price-to-earnings ratio of 20.81, a figure greater than 70% of its sector peers. The company's price-to-free cash flow ratio is 19.45, greater than 70% of its sector peers. These values are calculated using the stock's price at last market close.



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Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings).

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analystdriven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. Please go to http://global.morningstar.com/ equitydisclosures for information about Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies.

ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10% Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

 $Very\ High\ -$ the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

 $\ensuremath{\textit{Extreme}}$ — the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Strong - assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

i. Last Close – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation**– Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.
