São Paulo, October 19, 2020 - BRASKEM S.A. (B3: BRKM3, BRKM5 and BRKM6; NYSE: BAK; LATIBEX: XBRK), further to the Notice to the Market dated October 7, 2020, hereby announces to its shareholders and the market that, after implementing the applicable procedures for safe return of its activities, it has reestablished normal access to most of its servers and software, enabling Braskem to resume the normal operations.

In addition, the Company continues to investigate the possibility if there was any breach of personal data and information, and to date no confirmation to that effect has been found.

The Company continues to undertake its best efforts to assess the extent of the incident, taking appropriate measures, including from a criminal perspective, and it is unable at this point to assure what the eventual impacts arising from the incident might be.

Lastly, Braskem will keep the market informed in compliance with the applicable laws and regulations.
