MATERIAL FACT

Braskem S.A. ("Braskem" or "Company"), in compliance with CVM Instruction 358/02, informs its shareholders and the market that it has been informed by its controlled company Braskem Idesa regarding the receipt of notification from the Centro Nacional de Control del Gas Natural ("Cenagas"), a Mexican state-owned agency solely responsible for the natural gas pipelines and transportation in the region, related to the unilateral termination of the service of natural gas transportation, an essential energy input for the production of polyethylene in the Petrochemical Complex of Mexico.

As a result, in compliance with safety protocols, Braskem Idesa initiated procedures for the immediate interruption of its operating activities, which may have a material effect on the Company's operating or financial results, depending on the timing of the stoppage.

Braskem Idesa will take applicable legal measures to protect its rights and find a solution for the issue, and it cannot estimate, at this time, the date for the return of its activities.

The Company will keep the market informed of any developments relating to this matter to the extent required by applicable law.
