
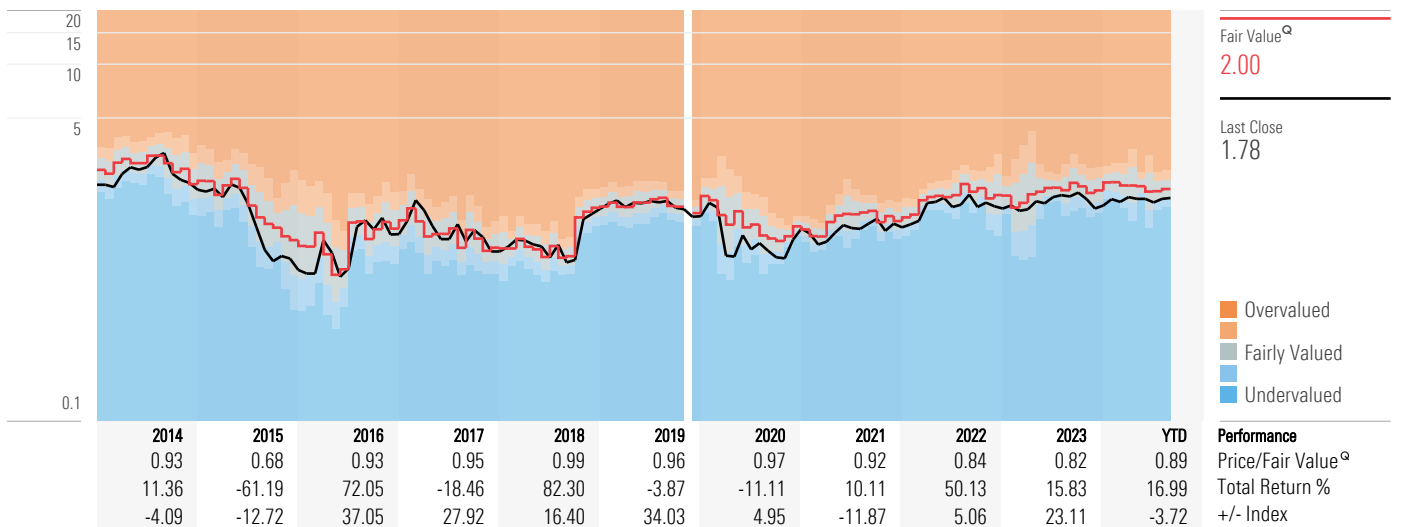

## Business Description

Cia Energetica DE Minas Gerais - Cemig Formerly Energy Company of Minas Gerais is a Brazilian power company that generates, transmits, and distributes electricity. As one of the largest power companies in Brazil, the firm operates across most Brazilian states and Chile. The company has various subsidiaries and operates chiefly through its generation, transmission, distribution, and gas segments. The majority of the company's revenue is derived from electricity sales to consumers. The company generates power primarily through hydroelectric resources and secondarily through thermal and wind resources.

## Valuation <sup>Q</sup> as of 8 Aug 2024

Morningstar maintains a 4-star quantitative star rating for Cia Energetica DE Minas, derived from the firm's valuation and uncertainty scores. The company's shares last closed at 1.78, below our quantitative fair value estimate of 2.05. These shares have traded between a 25.14% and 6.37% discount to their fair value estimate over the past year. In Morningstar's equity coverage universe for this methodology, the company's valuation rating lands at the 80th percentile; in the utilities sector, the firm's score lies at the 62nd percentile. Furthermore, Cia Energetica DE Minas maintains a quantitative valuation uncertainty rating of High. The company has held this star rating since the previous rating of 3, which was last assigned on 08/01/2024. The uncertainty rating for Cia Energetica DE Minas has remained High since the previous rating of Very High, which was last assigned on 07/25/2024. The key factors behind these ratings are the company's earnings yield and volatility. The earnings yield is 17.95%, and its maximum annualized trailing 12-month volatility is 28.09%. The earnings

yield falls at the 92nd percentile in the utilities sector while the volatility is at the 44th percentile. Over the past year, the company's earnings yield has been between 14.55% and 26.82%; its volatility has ranged between 18.11% and 28.09%.


## Economic Moat <sup>Q</sup> as of 8 Aug 2024

Morningstar maintains a quantitative moat rating of None on the company. The firm's quantitative moat score of 0.22 sits at the 20th percentile in the utilities sector. This is a decrease from 0.47, the maximum of its moat scores over the past year. The quantitative financial health rating for Cia Energetica DE Minas is Moderate. Its financial health score, termed Distance to Default, sits at the 59th percentile in the universe and 73rd percentile in the sector. The significant drivers of these ratings are the company's book value yield and enterprise value-to-market value ratio. The book value yield for Cia Energetica DE Minas is 82.64%, and its enterprise value-to-market value ratio is 1.21. They sit at the 61st and 64th percentile in the global equity universe, respectively.

## Fundamentals as of 8 Aug 2024

Cia Energetica DE Minas reports earnings per share of 1.93. Its return on invested capital is 17.48%. The company maintains a dividend yield of 11.12%, paying out 57.77% of earnings. These values are calculated over a trailing 12-month period. As of last market close, Cia Energetica DE Minas has a price-to-earnings ratio of 5.78, falling at the 12th percentile in its sector (where a lower percentile means a lower ratio) and ranging between 4.49 and 6.92 over the past year. The company's price-to-free cash flow ratio is 5.51, falling at the 22nd percentile in its sector and ranging between

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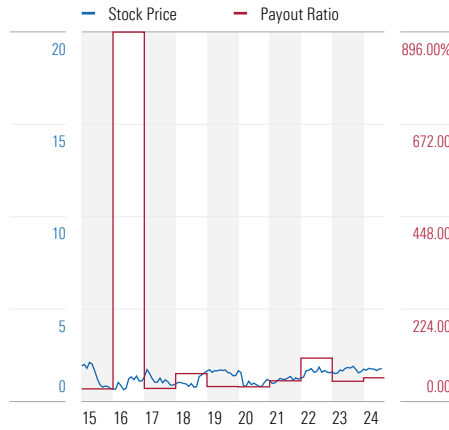

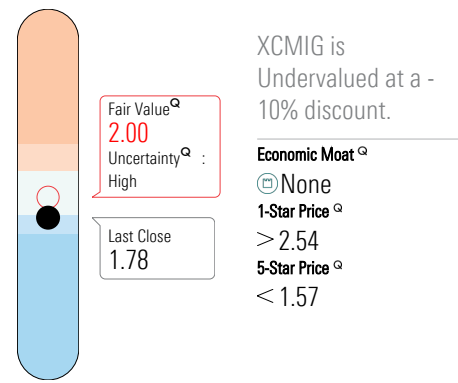

## Quantitative Equity Report Overview

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### Quantitative Equity Ratings

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings").

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analyst-driven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. Please go to <http://global.morningstar.com/equitydisclosures> for information about Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies.

ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

**Narrow** – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

**Wide** – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

**None** – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

★ – the stock is overvalued with a reasonable margin of safety.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

**Low** – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%

**Medium** – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

**High** – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

**Very High** – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

**Extreme** – the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

**Weak** – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

**Moderate** – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health is between 0.2 and 0.7

**Strong** – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

### Other Definitions

i. **Last Close** – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation** – Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

**Undervalued – Last Price** is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

**Fairly Valued – Last Price** is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

**Fairly Valued – Last Price** is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

**Overvalued – Last Price** is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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Sustainalytics analyzes over 1,300 data points to assess a company's exposure to and management of ESG risks. In other words, ESG Risk Ratings measures a company's unmanaged ESG Risks represented as a quantitative score. Unmanaged Risk is measured on an open-ended scale starting at zero (no risk) with lower scores representing less unmanaged risk and, for 95% of cases, the unmanaged ESG Risk score is below 50.

Based on their quantitative scores, companies are grouped into one of five Risk Categories (negligible, low, medium, high, severe). These risk categories are absolute, meaning that a 'high risk' assessment reflects a comparable degree

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The ESG Risk Rating Assessment is a visual representation of Sustainalytics ESG Risk Categories on a 1 to 5 scale. Companies with Negligible Risk = 5 Globes, Low Risk = 4, Medium Risk = 3 Globes, High Risk = 2 Globes, Severe Risk = 1 Globe.
