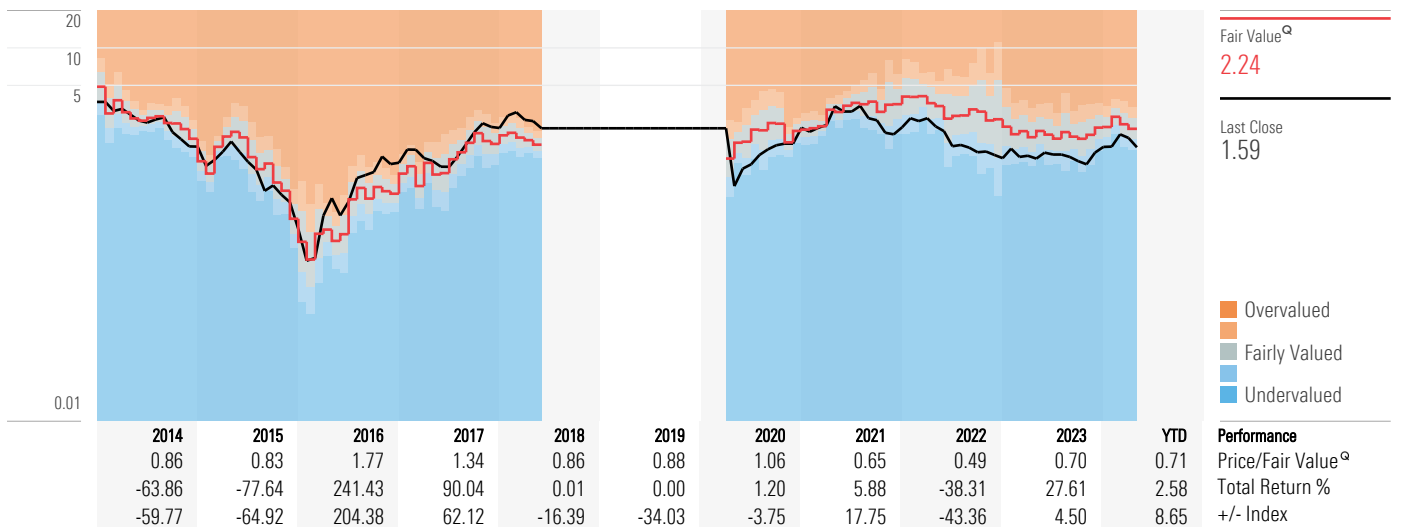

Business Description

Usinas Siderurgicas de Minas Gerais SA is a Brazil-based company that is primarily engaged in the production and distribution of flat steel products. The company's product portfolio consists of ordinary heavy plates, Sincron series premium heavy plates, hot strips, cold-rolled products, and galvanized products. These products are used in automotive, civil construction, railway, electric, white goods, offshore platforms, and agricultural and construction machinery. The Brazilian domestic market represents the majority of the company's sales, while the United States, Argentina, and Turkey are the three biggest export destination markets for the company.

Valuation ^Q as of 24 Apr 2024

Usinas Siderurgicas achieves a 4-star quantitative star rating based on Morningstar's equity model. This reflects the company's valuation and uncertainty scores under this assessment system. The Quantitative Fair Value estimate is 2.64, above the previous closing price of 1.89. The stock has been trading between a 40.8% and 22.34% discount to its quantitative fair value over the past year. The stock's current valuation rating sits at the 46th percentile in the coverage universe and 65th percentile in the basic materials sector (higher percentile indicates more undervalued). The quantitative uncertainty rating for Usinas Siderurgicas is Very High. Our quantitative star rating last differed from the current rating on 04/01/2024; the uncertainty rating last differed on 04/18/2024. The previous ratings were 3 and High, respectively. The main drivers of the company's valuation and uncertainty are its earnings yield and drawdown. The earnings yield of 10.22% falls at the 85th percentile in the equity universe and the 90th percent-

ile in its sector. The trailing 12-month maximum drawdown of 23.57% corresponds to the 39th percentile overall and the 23rd percentile in the industry.


Economic Moat ^Q as of 24 Apr 2024

With a Morningstar quantitative moat rating of None, the quantitative moat score for Usinas Siderurgicas falls below the 5th percentile in both the basic materials sector and equity coverage universe. The company has maintained its None quantitative moat rating for the last year. We also assign a Moderate quantitative financial health rating to Usinas Siderurgicas. The company's raw score on this metric, termed Distance to Default, ranks at the 54th percentile overall and 69th in the basic materials sector. Furthermore, this financial health rating has stayed Moderate over the last year. Supporting these ratings are the company's book value yield and enterprise value-to-market value ratio. The book value yield of 183.35%, ranks at the 89th percentile in the covered equity universe and at the 87th percentile among its peers. Meanwhile, its enterprise value-to-market value ratio of 1.10, falls at the 56th percentile in the universe and the 64th percentile in the basic materials sector.

Fundamentals as of 24 Apr 2024

The earnings per share for Usinas Siderurgicas is 0.72. The company earns a return on invested capital of 4.36%, falling at the 70th percentile in the basic materials sector. The firm maintains a dividend yield of 3.34%. We calculate the above figures over a trailing 12-month period. Examining valuation further, we find Usinas Siderurgicas holds a price-to-earnings ratio of 14.57, a figure greater than 42% of its sector peers. The

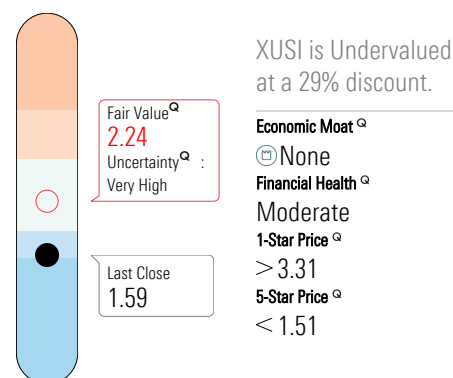

Quantitative Equity Report Overview

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Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings").

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analyst-driven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%

Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

Very High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

Extreme – the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Moderate – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health is between 0.2 and 0.7

Strong – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

Other Definitions

i. **Last Close** – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation** – Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Fairly Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Fairly Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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Sustainalytics analyzes over 1,300 data points to assess a company's exposure to and management of ESG risks. In other words, ESG Risk Ratings measures a company's unmanaged ESG Risks represented as a quantitative score. Unmanaged Risk is measured on an open-ended scale starting at zero (no risk) with lower scores representing less unmanaged risk and, for 95% of cases, the unmanaged ESG Risk score is below 50.

Based on their quantitative scores, companies are grouped into one of five Risk Categories (negligible, low, medium, high, severe). These risk categories are absolute, meaning that a 'high risk' assessment reflects a comparable degree

of unmanaged ESG risk across all subindustries covered.

The ESG Risk Rating Assessment is a visual representation of Sustainalytics ESG Risk Categories on a 1 to 5 scale.
